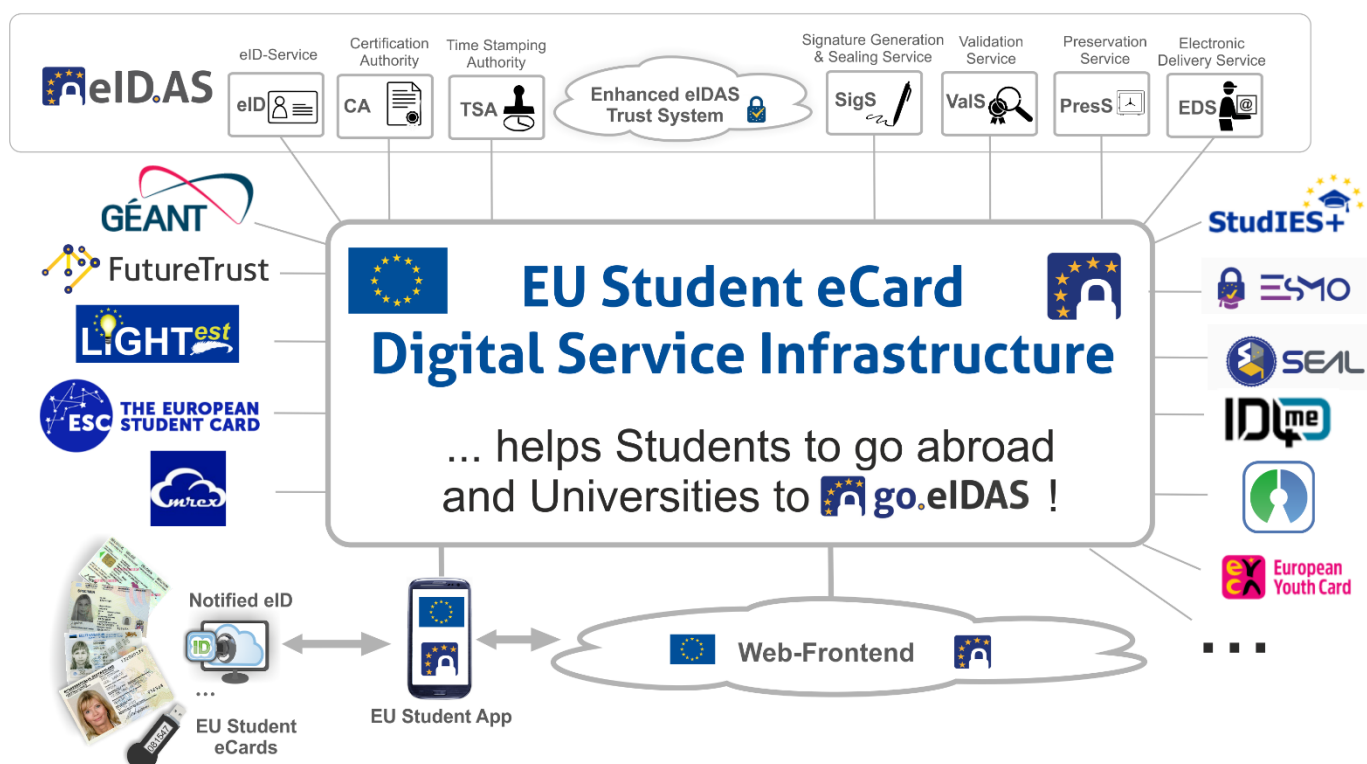




Working Group
